

INIKUDULIIUN —

A few years ago after I crossed the finish line of a 50-mile ultra marathon, I went into the men's dressing room and took a shower. The entire time I was in the shower, I heard this other finisher groaning in anguish.

Upon exiting the shower, still wrapped in my towel, I saw him, completely naked, sitting on a toilet in front of me. He looked up at me and said, "I can't get up. Can you help me up?"

My first thought was, "Seriously, bro? You're naked. You stink like poop. You're dirty and gross. Did I mention, dude, you're naked. Nah, I'm gonna take a pass. I just got out of the shower and I'm nice and clean. Sorry, you're on your own."

But before I knew what was happening, I walked over and reached out my hand. And I started helping him up.

Why? Because there was a time when I was that guy. I was a stench in God's nostrils with my sin. I was dirty and gross. I was vulnerable and unable to do anything to help myself up or to clean myself up. And God, holy and perfect and clean in every way, heard my groans and cries. Out of His great love and mercy, He reached down and pulled me up.

He took my stinking, filthy sin and washed me clean through His Son, Jesus. That day I confessed with my mouth that Jesus is Lord and believed in my heart that God raised Him from the dead – on that day I was saved and changed.

2 Corinthians Chapter 5 tells me that I am a new creation in Christ, that the old has passed away and the new has come. Verses 18-20 say this,


"All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us."

We – you and I who have been reconciled to God through Christ have been given the message and ministry of reconciliation. We are new creations now serving as ambassadors for Christ.

# TURN <u>Your</u> passion into <u>your</u> mission

We believe that God gives us opportunities to run with other people so we can share the Good News with those runners so they might experience the immeasurable riches of a life that is anchored to Jesus.

This involves the "who, when, where, what, why, and how" of turning your passion for running into your mission as an ambassador for Christ.

So, let's walk through those in a quick question and answer sequence...

# WHO IS RUNNING WITH YOU THAT NEEDS TO HEAR GOOD NEWS?

Every. Single. Runner. Every single runner you know needs to hear the Good News of Jesus Christ. We ALL need to be told and reminded of who Jesus is and the abundant life that He has for us, for whatever specific situation and season of life we are in. Your first step is to make a list of runners that you can run with, and begin praying for those on your list.

# WHEN AND WHERE DO YOU RUN WITH OTHERS?

There are intersections where our feet and our lives cross paths with other runners. Turning your passion into your mission means showing up at the right time and the right place. The roads, trails, tracks, and treadmills are more than places for you to get some miles in; they are your place in the ministry field. Make a list of times and places you can run with other people.

# WHAT CAN YOU DO TO MODEL THE CHRISTIAN FAITH THROUGH RUNNING?

Learn this: you can't do everything, but you can do something! In the simplest of terms, other runners need to see you treasure Jesus so much that they want to treasure Him too. Illustrate with your actions and communicate with your words that life with Jesus is far better than life without Him. God has divinely appointed and strategically positioned you precisely where you are precisely at this season of life precisely with the runners around you to represent Jesus to them. Love God. Love others. On the run.

# HOW CAN YOU TALK ABOUT THE GOSPEL WITH OTHER RUNNERS?

Conversations with other runners before, during, and after runs are a cornerstone of the sport. Use these opportunities to speak life to those who are running with you. What they need most isn't good advice, but rather Good News! Use your conversations to point them to Jesus so they can find in Him what nothing else in this world can deliver. Your words are not your words. They are Jesus' words spoken through you. You are an ambassador speaking on His behalf, sharing the message of reconciliation, telling others to come find life in Jesus.

# WHY ARE YOU LACING UP YOUR SHOES TO RUN?

Ultimately, your mission is to make disciples. You are to help them take the next step – whether that is the first step or the ten-thousandth step – in their journey of experiencing the real life of joy, hope, peace, acceptance, guidance, and love that is found in knowing and following Jesus. We will never spread the Good News through addition (our own efforts) but rather through multiplication (the efforts of many) by encouraging and equipping other runners to join us in the mission. As an ambassador for Christ, you are to help unbelievers become ambassadors too and help believers become better ambassadors!

<u>The question is</u>: what might this look like in a real life example? In the next section you'll see what we are doing in our own running community.



# WHAT WE ARE DOING IN OUR COMMUNITY

In carrying out the Great Commandments and the Great Commission, what specifically takes place? Every activity involved in turning our passion into our mission falls into one of the following three categories...

#### CATEGORY

1

#### GOING.

We go where the runners are and simply love them like Jesus. Whether this is meeting up for a run with a friend or participating in a Taco Tuesday group run, we go have fun with our runner friends and try to show them the heart of our loving God. We model Jesus' servant attitude by volunteering at events, hosting aid stations, supporting causes, and helping out our runner friends on and away from the course. When we are around other runners we try to answer one simple question: how would Jesus act if He were in his favorite pair of Hokas running with us? And we aim for that. All along the way, we pray for people, inject the Good News of Jesus into the conversation when appropriate, and invite people to join us for a...

#### **CATEGORY**

2

#### **GATHERING.**

A few times each month (weather permitting) we meet at a popular running locale for a FAITH AND FUN GROUP RUN. Prior to the start of the group run, Pastor Jimmy (or a guest speaker) shares a 10-15 minute message. These messages begin with a runner story illustration, then dive into a relevant Biblical truth, and culminate in the presentation of the Gospel. These gatherings are posted as events on Facebook in advance and we average about twenty people who attend. Pastor Jimmy has been invited to share one of these messages at pre-race gatherings to popular events in Omaha, NE with as many as 100 people attending.

Additionally, we host cookouts, game nights, Christmas parties, running documentary screenings, and a variety of other events for runners in our home. With each of these there is usually a very short gospelcentered devotional that is shared with those who attend.

<u>The point of these gatherings is threefold</u>: to proclaim the Good News of Jesus, to let people get to know what we are all about, and to invite them to dig deeper into the message through a small group study.

#### **CATEGORY**

3

#### GROUPING.

The ultimate goal is for people to join us in a Sunday night Bible study in our home where we can talk more about how God desires to change our lives for our infinite good and His glory. We host a long-term discipleship program on Sunday nights where we talk about real life issues, how the Good News of Jesus

provides a solution to those issues, and encourage each other to live in line with the truth of the Gospel for our joy and His praise. In these studies we show the beauty of God's design for all things, the brokenness that occurs when we abandon His design, and how restoration is possible as we believe the Good News of Jesus more fully in more areas of our lives.

# What we ultimately want to see happen is this: As runners grow in their faith, they too GO, GATHER and GROUP to multiply.

As such, our resources are made available for any runner (including you) to take and use in your own community to turn your passion into your mission.

- Use our Gospel-centric, runner-themed discipleship lessons to start a group or work with someone oneon-one to experience the kind of joy-filled life change that only Jesus can bring.
- Give away our Runner Stories CD to runners in your own community (and at race locales as you travel) to share six Gospel-centric, runner-themed messages. Each are between 10-15 minutes in length.
- Share our short, inspirational videos (with actual running footage and a succinct Gospel-thought) with other runners to point them towards Jesus in just 1-3 minutes.
- Get trained yourself by reading through our training materials to learn more about the "who, when, where, what, why, and how" of turning your passion for running into your mission as an ambassador for Christ.
- Reach out to us with questions about serving as an ambassador for Christ in the running community. We are happy to help in any way that we can.

The important thing is this: start loving God and loving people through running.

Running can be so much more than just running. It can be a means of grace that God uses as a part of His purpose for the good of people and the glory of His Name.

#### Let's never lose sight of the end game: to make much of the King of Kings, Jesus Christ.

Ultimately, we desire to bring honor and glory to our God and see His image-bearers span the globe into every nation, tribe, people and tongue to the praise of the King of all creation. We invite you to join us.

Just think about it: when you turn your passion into your mission, you get to run some miles as part of the greatest work in the universe as God's ambassador of love to other runners. So, go run. Go make disciples.
